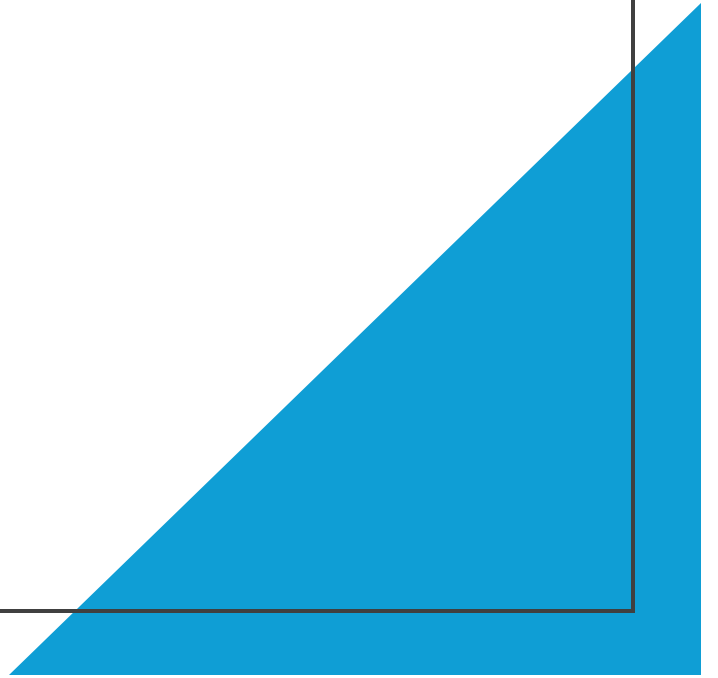

What happens next?

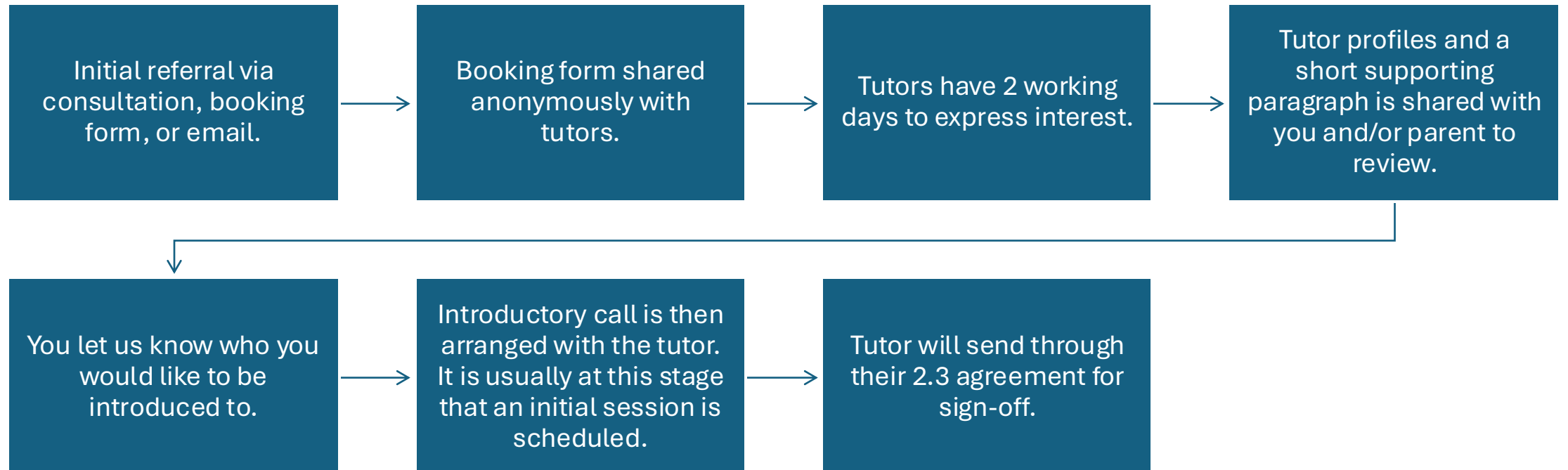
